- **Show Begins: 7:00 PM**

**Recital Photo Day: Saturday, June 5 & Sunday, June 6 – Schedule will be handed out during class times.**

### RECITAL

- **Friday, June 11, 2010**
- Time: 7:00pm
  - **Dancers & “Backstage Moms” to arrive promptly at 6:15 PM.** Dancers should be dressed and ready - see “COSTUME: Dress Requirements.” DO NOT ARRIVE OR ENTER THE AUDITORIUM IN YOUR COSTUME!!
  - **Show will begin at 7:00 PM.**
- **Location: Deer Park High School Crawford Auditorium (8351 Plainfield Road Cincinnati, Ohio 45243)**
- When the dancers are not performing, they will be backstage.
- Please follow the posted signs for parking, auditorium and backstage areas.

### DRESS REHEARSAL

- **Thursday, June 10, 2010**
- Time: 5:30pm
  - **ALL students:** Please arrive promptly at **5:30 PM.**
  - We will run through the whole show in ORDER once. Please know some routines may do their routine a couple times to ensure correct staging, music and lighting. As soon as your child has finished rehearsing their routine you are free to leave.
  - Dancers should be dressed and ready in full hair, makeup and costume - see “COSTUME: Dress Requirements.”
- Location: **Deer Park High School Crawford Auditorium (8351 Plainfield Road Cincinnati, Ohio 45243)**
- This dress rehearsal is only open to dancers, backstage moms, staff, and 1 parent per student.
- Attendance is **MANDATORY** for all participating dancers.
- When the dancers are not performing, they will be backstage.

### RECITAL PHOTO DAY

- **Saturday June 5 & Sunday June 6, 2010**
- Time: SEE SCHEDULE - Each class should take approximately 15-30 minutes to photograph.
- Location: Cincy Dance Studio

- Photo pricing – **ORDER FORMS WILL BE HANDED OUT IN CLASS CLOSER TO THE PHOTO DATES!**
- Dress requirements – see “COSTUME: Dress Requirements”
- The photos will be taken by Oak Haven Photography. They will consist of a group shot, then an individual photo. It is not mandatory that you purchase a photo package, but we would prefer that all students attend photo day so that they will appear in their class photo.

## **COSTUMES**

**THERE ARE NO REPLACEMENT COSTUMES OR TIGHTS!!** If a costume and or tights are lost or damaged, we will not be able to replace it. Parents: please do not allow the students to wear their costumes or tights prior to the photos & performances.

- Parents: please have the students try their costumes on to see if alterations need to be made. Many times, pants will need to be hemmed, shoulder straps will need to be tacked on, tutus may need to be steamed, etc. If you need assistance or advice on alterations, please let the studio know.
- Costumes will be distributed during their regular class time. E-mail will be sent out when you dancers class will be receiving their costumes. A parent should attend class that day to receive any instructions on the costume.

## **SHOES**

All students must have clean shoes in good condition for the recital. Please see your child’s costume listing located in the Pink book in our lobby to see which shoes are required for your class. Contact Lauren or ask your instructor if you have any questions regarding shoes. **ALL DANCERS MUST HAVE THE CORRECT STYLE AND COLOR TO PARTICIPATE!!**

## **DRESS REQUIREMENTS**

- Students must arrive at the dress rehearsal and photo day wearing: costume, tights, accessories, and hair/make-up done! **DO NOT ARRIVE OR ENTER THE AUDITORIUM IN YOUR COSTUME ON RECITAL NIGHT.** There will be a backstage area for your child to change and get ready for their performance.
- Fingernails: NO nail polish.
- Jewelry: No rings, bracelets, necklaces, watches, etc. Only small post or stud type earrings, or no earrings.
- Please put the dancers name in/on all items (costume, shoes, accessories, etc.).
- Bring a “fashion emergency” kit: safety pins, bobby pins, hair spray, make-up, etc.

## **RECITAL HAIR & MAKE-UP**

The following is a guide, but please feel free to ask the instructor if you have any questions:

- Tippy 2’s: Please style student’s hair half up in curls (sides/top away from their face). Make a bow with enclosed shorter ribbon, and attach to the top portion of back of head.
- Creative Movement: Please style the student’s hair in a high bun with no part.
- Kinder Tuesday: Please style the student’s hair with the sides/top away from their face and in curls. Bobby pin headpiece to their hair. Your instructor will show you where to pin the headpiece on your child.
- Ballet Level 1: Please style the student’s hair in a high bun with no part.
- Ballet Level 2: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Ballet Level 3 & Pointe: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Ballet 4: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Hip Hop 1: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Hip Hop 2, 3 and 4: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Jazz 1: Please style the student’s hair with the sides/top away from their face and in curls. Your instructor will show you where to pin the headpiece on your child.
- Jazz 2: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Jazz 3: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Jazz 4: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Tap 1: Please style the student’s hair with the sides/top away from their face and in curls. Bobby pin headpiece to their hair. Your instructor will show you where to pin the headpiece on your child.

- Tap 2&3: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Tap 4: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Opening Number: Part to the left side and slick back into a low straightened pony tail. Please wrap a piece of hair around the pony tail holder and secure with bobby pins. NO FLYWAYS!
- Adult Dance Combo: Please style student's hair partially or all back (away from face). If hair is long enough, tie the enclosed hair strips around a ponytail (may want to double knot) – no bow – let the ends of the ribbon fall to the sides naturally. If hair isn't long enough, attach hair strips to hair as you feel will look best on the student.

GENERAL HAIR NOTES: Please follow the hair instructions above. To help hair stay in place, use LOTS of HAIR GEL, HAIR SPRAY & BOBBY PINS!! If the hair is shoulder length, please try to pull it back partially and part to the left side. If hair is short, please try to leave a part on the right side & style the rest as you feel looks best. **If the student has bangs, please pull them back off of face.**

- MAKE-UP: We recommend: mascara, blush and a darker shade of lipstick at minimum. You can also use foundation, eye shadow, eyeliner, false eyelashes, glitter, etc. Again, feel free to ask if you have any questions.

## TICKETS

- Tickets go on sale **Saturday May 15<sup>th</sup> from 12-4pm @ Cincy Dance Studio.**
- Tickets will be offered to everyone (without limits, until we sell out). Therefore, it is important for you to purchase your tickets on the day they go on sale. Each student will receive ONE free ticket. If available, tickets can also be purchased at the dress rehearsal & recital.
- Cost: \$10 per ticket (\$12 at dress rehearsal & recital)
- Everyone must have a ticket to enter the auditorium (with the exception of the dancers & Backstage Moms. **Anyone who does not have a ticket will not be permitted to enter.**

## BACKSTAGE MOMS

We ask that two Moms volunteer from each Tippy 2's, Preschool and Kinder Combo Class – one Mom from each Level 1, 2, 3, & 4 class - to stay with the dancers during the recital. A friend or family member who is 18 years or older can also be a Backstage Mom. For dancers who are in more than 2 dances, it may be helpful to have an assistant backstage (just for them) to help with quick costume changes. For the dancers, it's comforting to have a consistent parental / adult presence during the event. For the studio, it's help that we couldn't do without!! **As a Backstage Mom, you will not have to pay for a ticket for the recital. You will be able to watch your child's performance in the audience (we'll have a special Backstage Mom's seating area), and then will stay with the class backstage for the rest of the recital.** We hate to exclude the Dads, but we think it's best to keep it "just girls" for reasons such as costume changes, etc. Thank you so much, and please let the studio know if you are interested in helping!

## GENERAL RECITAL RULES

- Audience may enter and exit the theater between performances ONLY - not during.
- No flash photography or video taping will be allowed at the recital.
- **Videotaping - provided by Flip Box Productions. DVD's are available for purchase for \$25.00. Order forms are located in the lobby. Flip Box provides a high quality and low cost service for our students, and we prefer that the audience uses this service (No personal video taping will be allowed at the recital).**
- Please turn off all cellular phones & beepers during the performance.
- We would like to ask for complete silence during the rehearsal and the performance (of course, we encourage you to applaud at the end of each performance). All small children should be kept in their seats and supervised by their parents.
- Everyone must have a ticket (with the exception of the dancers, "Backstage Moms" and infants that will be sitting on an adult's lap). Anyone without a ticket will not be permitted to enter.
- **No food or drink inside the theater.**

## REHEARSING AT HOME

*The following will lead to a LESS STRESSFUL & MORE ENJOYABLE recital for your child!*

- All students will receive a CD of the music they will be performing to.
- It is helpful for Tippy 2's and Preschool students to know their music when they dance. Please encourage them to "rehearse" ☺
- It's also very helpful for older students (Levels 1 - 4) to listen to and understand their music. We strongly encourage that students do "routine run throughs" at home a few times a week. Additionally, we suggest that the students stretch on their own 2 or 3 times per week.
